SUMMARY OF DEGREE REQUIREMENTS – BIBLE EXAM / CURRICULUM HOURS: 66 (48 core hours; 18 elective hours)

‡ 12 elective hours must come from the following courses: AT310 Christian Formation & Calling, AT340 Theology of Ministry & Worship, CC310 Foundations for Apologetics & Outreach, CM310 Communicating the Scriptures + CM320/1 Preaching/Communicating the New Testament, CO320 Counseling in the Church I, EM301 Educational Foundations, WM310 God's World Mission. 6 remaining elective hours are unrestricted. Electives may be taken in any term.

<> Can be either CH310 Ancient & Medieval Church History or CH320 Reformation & Modern Church History.

> Can be swapped for another course so marked in a different term.
