‡ 12 elective hours must come from the following courses: AT310 Christian Formation & Calling, AT340 Theology of Ministry & Worship, CC310 Foundations for Apologetics & Outreach, CM310 Communicating the Scriptures + CM320/1 Preaching/Communicating the New Testament, CO320 Counseling in the Church I, EM301 Educational Foundations, WM310 God's World Mission. 6 remaining elective hours are unrestricted. Electives may be taken in any term.

NOTE: English-based Bible courses at the 200 level will only be available online and may be offered in terms different than indicated above.
