### BIBLE EXAM

CURRICULUM HOURS: 66 (57 core hours; 9 elective hours)

- This is a required course. Students in it will also be assigned to a personal formation Cohort Group which will meet during the term.

‡ 6 elective hours must come from the following courses: AT310 Christian Formation & Calling, AT340 Theology of Ministry & Worship, CC310 Foundations for Apologetics & Outreach, CM310 Communicating the Scriptures + CM320/1 Preaching/Communicating the New Testament, CO320 Counseling in the Church I, EM301 Educational Foundations, WM310 God's World Mission. AT340, CM310 + CM320/1, and EM301 are available in hybrid format; all others can be taken online. 3 remaining elective hours are unrestricted. Electives may be taken in any term.
