** Students **wishing to form a concentration** may use the elective hours to follow one of the following concentration tracks: Biblical Studies and Christian Ministry, City Ministry, Counseling, Cultural Apologetics and Communication, or Educational Ministries. Students **not enrolling in a track** must use their electives in the following manner.

- 6 credits of electives must be in OT (Old Testament) or NT (New Testament).³
- 5 credits of electives must come from classes with the following prefixes: AT (Applied Theology), CC (Contemporary Culture), CG (Church Growth), CM (Communication), CO (Counseling), EM (Educational Ministries), WM (World Missions).
- 2 remaining credits are free electives.
- Electives may be taken in any term.
