MAC applicants must submit an additional 2 page essay discussing the applicant's:

- 1) Process for considering clinically-informed counseling as a career,
- 2) Successes and failures in forming relationships and keeping boundaries,
- 3) Respect for cultural diversity and personal experiences with diverse people groups,
- 4) Present views on the relationship between theology and psychology

DMIN applicants must submit a brief resume of your pastoral experience including dates of service. Additionally, please include the field(s) in which you desire to specialize, such as homiletics, counseling, etc.

Then you must be applying for the Grad Certificate, Non-Degree, or Auditor program.
